Jr. High Volleyball Tournament Information Sheet

General Information

- Columbus Scotus plays home volleyball games at the school. The address is 1554 18th Avenue. The entrance is on the north side of the building.
- Team bus parking can usually be found on 19th Avenue north or south of 16th Street. Please do not park buses in the church parking lot. Vans may be parked in the parking lot north of school.
- Andrew Sheridan is our athletic trainer. Feel free to inform him of any medical needs.
- No locker rooms will be assigned for this tournament. If you do not play consecutive matches, please claim a small section of bleachers for your team.
- 8th grade plays in Dowd activity Center. 7th grade plays in Memorial Hall. Fans should try to sit as families and space out where possible.
- There is a concession stand south of Dowd Activity Center. At this time, it will have limited offerings.
- Water fountains will not be available, but water bottle fillers are available.

Regular Admission

- Accepted Passes:
 - Only Scotus-issued passes accepted for this tournament
 - Visitor conference or faculty pass not honored for this tournament

Capacity

- Under current Directed Health Measures, indoor capacity is 75%. Memorial Hall has listed capacity 600. The Dowd Activity Center has listed capacity 1200.
- Only essential personnel will be allowed on the bench.
- Scorekeeper, clock operator, and libero tracker will be seated at the scorer's table.

Game Protocol

- Teams will not switch benches. Scotus will occupy the bench on the east in Dowd Activity Center and the north side of Memorial Hall.
- Scotus will provide a warm-up balls for both teams.
- There will be no pre-game or post-game handshake.
- Children should be seated with their parents.
- Fans and students should not go onto the court at the conclusion of the game.
- Fans and students are encouraged to leave the facility at the conclusion of the game.
- Restrooms are located south of the concession stand.
- No team meals will be allowed inside the building.

Masks and Face Coverings

- Fans and visiting students are encouraged to wear masks/coverings.
- Scotus players will wear masks/coverings when not competing.
- Scotus coaches will wear masks/coverings when they cannot socially distance.
- Game officials will not be required to wear masks/coverings.
- Concession workers will wear masks/coverings and gloves.
