Diocesan Scholarships

Good Shepherd Scholarships

Families within 225% of the Federal Poverty Level are eligible to receive a scholarship for up to 75% of tuition. Families must apply and complete the FACTS Scholarship application and submit tax documents to be eligible for the Good Shepherd Scholarship. Families apply for all scholarships and pay one application fee, for Diocesan and local scholarships, in FACTS each year.

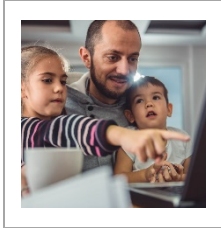
Scholarship Application Timeline



Applications are accepted from January 1st to March 31 each year. The deadline to apply and submit documentation is March 31. Schools will provide Scholarship Award Letters by the end of May. All scholarship awards will be deducted from tuition.

Local Scholarships

Family Tuition Cap Scholarship



Families of all income levels are eligible to apply for the Family Tuition Cap Scholarship. Families pay for the first three students and the rest are not charged tuition. Families **must** apply in the FACTS Scholarship system and submit tax documents to be eligible for the Family Tuition Cap Scholarship.

Aquinas Guardian Angel Scholarship



Aquinas Catholic Schools guarantees that a family will not pay more than 7% of their Adjusted Gross Income in order to receive the many benefits of a Catholic education.

Lincoln Diocese Catholic School Scholarships Scholarship Programs

Beginning in 2019 this diocesan-wide scholarship program has offered financial assistance to bridge the gap for families between tuition costs and their ability to pay. These Diocesan Scholarships were introduced to help low-income and middle-income families and to provide an additional source of scholarship funding for Catholic Schools. The Good Shepherd Scholarships and the Family Tuition Cap Scholarships are available to any student, regardless of their religious affiliation.

Tuition in the Diocese of Lincoln

Tuition assistance is available locally through every school in the Lincoln Diocese and every child receives a significant discount from the cost of education. This, however, still leaves over 2,000 children diocesan-wide who need additional financial assistance. The Good Shepherd Scholarship was introduced to support these families.
