Aquinas Families,

Welcome back! The 62nd Academic School Year is off and running! It is a joy to have your sons and daughters back in the building. The summer was too quiet without them.

Holy Family ELC Openings – On August 4th, sadly we had to reduce our numbers at Holy Family due to a lack of employees. The Center is required by Nebraska State Law to follow ratios (employees to children) or Holy Family could be shut down. We have hired two full-time employees and a part time employee. We continue to need both full-time and part-time workers at Holy Family. Again, even if your availability is only a couple of days a week, please consider putting in an application. Cheerleading – For the first time in twenty years we have a Spirit Coach and Cheerleaders for the 2023-2024 school year. Last Friday, we had an awesome Pep Rally teaching the students the new cheers and getting them out of their seats. Let's build up the school spirit this year.

Security – We are in the process of completing some much-needed security upgrades for both the Elementary and MS/HS buildings. The hope is to have these projects completed during the month of October.

First Vows – Just a few weeks ago, Sr. Guadalupe (Marissa DeWispelare, Class of '13) took her first vows as a Marian Sister of the Diocese of Lincoln. Sr. Guadalupe has completed an initial year as a postulant and a year as a novice (this is the year she actually wears a habit and takes a religious name). This begins the next stage of discernment in preparation for her final vows. As a professed member of the community she will be assigned to duties at the Motherhouse or elsewhere in the Diocese.

Thank You – As I mentioned last month we had many projects that we worked on this summer. A big thank you to Jason Campbell (tearing out broken concrete on the north side of the building), Craig Svoboda (drywalling and mudding of the new counselor office), Scott Samek (wiring for the new counselor office and new principal office), Custom Edge Curbing (new flower beds around the chapel and curbing) and Tom Pohl (cutting our old water tank into pieces to be scrapped). Their time and generosity is greatly appreciated.

Food – Thank you to Amanda Stutzman and Becky Romshek (feeding teachers and providing donuts the 2nd day of school), Bobbi Schmid (providing chicken and beverages for our teacher back to school dinner) and El Centenario (lunch for new teacher orientation and lunch for teacher in-service).

Counselor – I cannot stress enough how important this new position is to our school. As I said back in May, the new school counselor is there to be a bridge for your student to his teachers and a bridge for parents with any issues both academic or personal. Please utilize Mrs. Miriovsky's skills and time as we try to better serve our students and you the parents.

Middle/High School Principal update- September 2023

And just like that, the 2023-2024 school year is off and running. There was no proverbial dipping of the toe into the water this time around, it seems more like we were collectively picked up and dumped straight into the deep end with no choice but to swim. We've got students in the building, we've got an actual bell system to signal the beginning and end of class periods, we've got athletic contests being rescheduled due to 110+ degree heat indexes, we've got education happening. It feels like we've got it all. But most importantly, we've got Jesus. This year's theme of Truly Present obviously references the True Presence of Jesus Christ sacramentally in the Eucharist, but it doesn't end there. I have challenged our teachers and our students, and I now extend the same challenge to our parents. As we go through this school year, take advantage of the diocese-wide Eucharistic opportunities to deepen your relationship with Jesus. But my challenge to you is to also make a concerted effort to be truly present to those around you; your families, your coworkers, your friends. Enjoy spending intentional time with others growing in Catholic camaraderie. Put down the phones, turn off the TV, and have meaningful conversations. Get to know something new about a coworker you didn't know before. Have a heart-to-heart conversation with your children. Plan an activity for the family not involving technology. Be truly present to those around you, and avail yourself of the True Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

Current news

- **Community service hours requirement-** This year we will be reinstating a community service hours requirement for students. This program is intended to instill a service-oriented mindset in our students; service for their school, service for their parishes, and service for their community. A quick summary of the service program: high school students will complete 15 hours of service each year, for a total of 60 hours to be eligible for graduation, middle school students will complete 10 hours of service each year, for a total of 30 hours to be eligible for promotion to high school. The required totals for graduation or promotion will be prorated (i.e. current 7th grade students will need to complete 20 total hours- 10 in 7th grade, 10 in 8th grade- to be eligible for promotion to high school). Service may not be done for relatives, a for-profit business, or a business/organization by whom the student is also employed. Service hours will be submitted to a student's House teacher(s), who will help the student track their hours year after year. Forms to submit service hours will be available from House teachers.
- **Contact info request-** Parents, please make sure to log on to the PowerSchool Parent Portal and make any updates necessary to your contact information so we are able to contact you. Phone numbers, addresses, and email addresses sometimes change but don't get updated on PowerSchool, so we are unable to get in contact with you until we become aware of the change. This is also how we create the School Messenger notices that go out (i.e. texts, emails, and phone calls in case of a snow day), so it is very important we have the correct contact information. 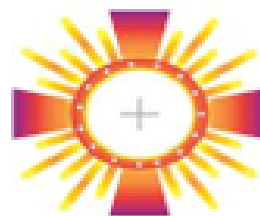

Aquinas Catholic Elementary School Picture Day is Friday, September 1.

You have the choice of over 60 backgrounds, and you may also use more than one background (and pose) in your package. This can all be previewed online when you receive your proofs. If you prefer the traditional blue background, that is one of the choices. Due to the variety of choices, all orders must be placed online, but if you prefer to pay with cash or check, that option is available.

Proofs: About 2 weeks after Picture Day you will receive a **Proof** of your student's **2 poses**. The Proof has the **Website** and **Password** to place your order **online**.

If you do not wish to pay with a credit card: **Still place the order online** and select **Cash** or **Check** as the **method of payment** upon checkout. Place cash or check in the **Payment Envelope** that came with your Proof. Write your **Order Confirmation Number** from your online order on the **Payment Envelope**.

Family Plan: When you pay for two children in your family, this qualifies you for a FREE package of equal or lesser value for all other children in your family. If you qualify for the Family Plan, here is how to obtain your FREE packages: After placing your two paid orders, you may place your additional orders online, but instead of paying, choose payment type: FAMILY, and click APPLY, and submit. Then simply email info@pegasus-si.com with the two **Order Confirmation Numbers** that have been **paid** in full **along with the Order Confirmation Number** for the order that is **FREE**. Please be sure to **order and send email prior to the Due Date** on the proof to avoid any late fees – Do NOT wait for all student's proofs as deadline dates may vary if they attend another school or are a Retake. Your FREE order is ON HOLD until you email the Confirmation Numbers.

Retakes: If you prefer to have a retake, you may do so for any reason on Retake Day. Wait until you get your RETAKE Proof to place an order at that time. If you decide to order from your original Proof rather than the Retake, you'll receive a late fee, as it is past the Order Due Date.

Due Date: On your proof is an Order Due Date. If you submit your order AFTER the Due Date, you'll have a \$10 late fee and late orders can take up to 6 – 8 weeks after ordering.

Science Olympiad

Any 6th - 8th students interested in Science Olympiad need to write a paragraph about why they want to be in Science Olympiad and why they would make a great team member, and then give to Mrs. Mayo. Practices will be 3:30 -4:00 on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Any High Schoolers interested can also let Mrs. Mayo know so we can try to get a High School team put together. Attend whatever practices you can but mostly will be responsible for all preparations on your events.

Competitions will be Sat. Feb. 17 at Henry Doorly Zoo, Sat. March 16th at Brownelle Talbot School, and Sat. April 27th and UNL East Campus which is State competition.



Middle School Science started with a get to know you consensogram activity where student voted for favorite subjects, food, sport, and their feeling about starting back to school. We discovered most of us were feeling "just OK" about school, and the subjects were pretty evenly favorited, while PE was the favorite Specials class. The one that surprised Mrs. Mayo and other teachers was that students like working with a partner or alone more than working in groups. All grades are learning the 7 steps of Scientific Method and Claim Evidence Reasoning (CER). We did an experiment to see if we could remove the M from an M&M. You would be amazed that the M will float on water as the M&M dissolves in water. We did more practice of writing a CER by watching short videos that were trying to prove something, like Can penguins fly? , Are there shoes that can make you walk on water? , Does drinking Gatorade make you a baller like Michael Jordan? and more. Soon the 6th graders will be growing mold and the 7th graders will be learning about types of rocks and the rock cycle. Finally the 8th graders are going to learn about cells and all their organelles and their functions. We will be starting the Tower Garden again this year as soon as we purchase new grow lights , nutrients, and seedlings. If you wish to support the process contact Mrs. Mayo to see what you can do. Come in and visit to see all the fun we are having learning about our scientific world.

Role of the School Counselor

School counselors help each child to be their best by teaching skills for social, emotional, and personal growth. They encourage respect for self and others, good decision making skills, and personal safety. When students are experiencing distress which makes it difficult for them to participate or focus in the classroom, the counselor can help them to work through current concerns and find resources as needed. Counseling and instruction at Aquinas is always informed by Catholic teaching and its understanding of the human person.

Types of Counseling:

Individual: Students who are very upset or having a difficult time solving social problems can visit the counselor to discuss what is wrong. Together we will find various solutions to help the student get back to doing what all children want to do, work and play.

Group: Designed for students to support each other in learning social and emotional skills and through difficult life circumstances, including grief, conflicts and family stresses.

Classroom Instruction: This environment is used for providing prevention programs that addresses the needs of all students. Topics can include bullying, social skills, problem solving, etc.

TYPES OF REFERRALS

For Counseling Services

Self

A student may ask to visit the counselor if he or she is regularly:

- Feeling very upset and can't concentrate on school
- Dealing with a difficult social, behavioral, or emotional concern
- Worried about a classmate

Administration

The principal may refer a child to the counselor if they feel that the student is referred to their office due to social/emotional issues that may be better resolved in counseling than through the disciplinary process.

How Can I Help:

Students:

- Collaborative Skills
- Managing your feelings
- Learning how to control behavior
- Getting organized
- Setting and achieving goals
- Dealing with peer pressure and bullying
- Learning how to make decisions and problem solve

Parents:

- Exploring ways to help your child succeed
- Improving parent-child communication
- Providing recommendations for community resources
- Understanding developmental changes of childhood through adolescence

Teachers

A teacher may refer your child if he or she is:

- in an agitated state
- Frequently having a difficulty socially or emotionally
- Regularly exhibiting emotions or behaviors that are keeping him or her from being able to focus on school

Parents

You may request that your child visit the counselor by calling or sending in a note. Some reasons that you might request a meeting are:

- Your family is going through a difficult life event (a loss, conflict, recent move)
- Your child is going through frequent, recurrent disruptive emotions (anxiety or sadness)
- Your child is having difficulty forming friendships

Dear 2024 Seniors and Parents of 2024 Seniors,

Next year your son/daughter will be a senior. One of the most lasting and treasured reminders of this year will be the senior pictures which will be taken over the summer or the first part of the school year. You will be responsible for getting the following senior pictures to Mrs. Pokorny by **November 1, 2023**.

You need to have your photographer email your colored formal pose picture in a vertical billfold sized JPEG file at 250 dpi to me for the yearbook, composite, alumni board, press releases, and class video. This picture should be the colored formal indoor pose with a plain background. (This should be a head shot with no hands or lower arms visible please.) You are responsible for making sure the school has this by November 1st. They may email this to Mrs. Pokorny at

If we do not have your print by November 1st, you may miss out on being in the composite, yearbook, etc. or have to pay for the late fee to be included. Be sure to schedule your pictures to be taken by September 1st.

As we at Aquinas should always strive to live up to Christ's example of modesty and Christian decency, we ask that no inappropriate pictures be submitted for publication.

This would include:

Females-no off-the-shoulder dresses or blouses

Females-no tops with an immodest/low cut (cut of the top must be 1 inch above the line of cleavage); no spaghetti or thin straps on shoulders for dresses or blouses

Males-wear a collared shirt and tie. (A jacket is preferred but optional.)

**Nothing that goes against the current dress code, for example-tattoo/
body piercing, hair length (MUST be above the collar of the shirt), 'fad' hair styles, facial hair, etc.**

***Remember that by a colored formal pose, we are asking for a head shot with no hands or lower arms visible in the picture. The background should be plain/one color and NO outdoor shots.**

Again, remember to have your photographer email your colored formal vertical pose picture in a billfold sized JPEG file at 250 dpi to Mrs. Pokorny by November 1st.

The administration reserves the right to refuse any portrait deemed unacceptable or immodest. Please read and follow the instructions we have provided and there should be no problems.

Please note that you MUST sign the publicity permission form in PowerSchool (under Forms) when you register your student at the beginning of the school year in order to have the senior picture as part of our composite, yearbook, and any other publications who might ask for the formal shot.

If you don't plan to have senior pictures taken, Ms. Brown will take a formal head shot picture, but this must be arranged with her before November.
