Aquinas Families,

- (Update) Strategic Plan Thank you so much for participating in the Parent Survey last month. The feedback • was helpful as we begin to build a Strategic Plan for 2025-2030. The Strategic Plan process is being assisted by Eva Fujan. Eva has done numerous strategic plans for our Catholic schools including Bishop Neumann (where he own children graduated from), St. Cecilia's and she has helped us in our last two plans of 2015-2020 and 2020-2025. Following the Parent Survey, Eva presented the survey results to our teachers during our Professional Development Day on November 6<sup>th</sup>. This feedback was very positive most especially in the areas of spiritual development, challenging academic standards, happiness with the school, recommending the school to others and student preparedness for college and the future. That said constructive feedback was also given and will be taken into consideration in future planning, most especially communication and more communication to new families. Eva then did a SWOT analysis with our teachers breaking them into groups by department receiving feedback of strengths, weaknesses, external and internal challenges and opportunities. Eva and the Board of Advisors meet on November 20<sup>th</sup> to present these materials to our board and begin the process of updating our 5 Pillars and the definitions. In December, the application process will be opened to have parents, alumni, community members to serve on the five pillar sub-committees and the strategic planning team. Please get involved in this process.
- (Update) Security November 3<sup>rd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> the exterior band room doors and the chapel doors were replaced. This is part of the ongoing project to update our building and provide better security for our students. The front doors are next on the list to be replaced beginning in the Spring. This process was delayed as we will need to remove and replace the concrete in the front entrance to put more solid and deeper footings to properly secure the new front doors. These doors will have a separate exterior door just for parents and an interior door for students to have access to Mrs. Shonka in the office. As an extra security measure, we will be tinting our exterior doors. Again, thank you for your generosity towards this project.
- Parish Service Projects A big thank you to our students for their work here at both schools and at our parishes during our morning of Service Projects. Each house was assigned to a local parish during work needed around the rectory or parish grounds. This projects and photos have been running on or Aquinas Facebook page. A reminder how important this is for our community. Not only is it a way for our students to give back but it acknowledges the support our parishes give to Aquinas Catholic Schools. Our budget is roughly \$4 million dollars and over \$2 million comes from our thirteen local parishes. A perfect example of this is tuition. High School tuition is \$4055. The actual cost per student is over \$10,000. These low tuition rates would not be possible without the support of our parishes. Please be generous to your parishes as they sacrifice much for our schools.

#### Current news


