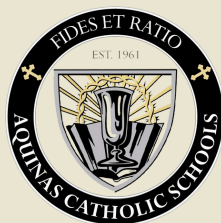


Mission Statement

- Develop strategies to strengthen engagement and support between the schools



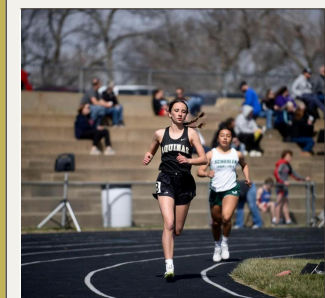
