Aquinas Families, December 2024

- Board of Advisors (BOA) Due to lack of membership and needing non-faculty voters, the BOA had an
 extra session in October to nominate and add members. While the board's primary role is to advise the
 CAO they do vote on the annual budget and on proposed tuition. Members were added to the BOA
 primarily from the from Strategic Pillar Committees. Nominations were held for a new Board President,
 Vice President, and Secretary. Congratulations and a big thank to the following new members of the
 BOA: Austin Witmer (President), Maggie Miratsky (Vice-President), Kelly Koranda (Recording
 Secretary), Phil Zegers, Trent Jakub, Jared DeWispelare, Kyle Eller, Christina Podolak, Ryan Meister, and
 Colleen Storm.
- Educational Scholarship While it was a great night for Life Initiatives 434 and 439, Initiative 435 was defeated 580,097 votes (57%) to 382,867 votes (42%). Some have asked why not as much effort was put into 435. Simply put, the Nebraska Catholic Conference has only so many resources and when it came to life issues those took precedent in trying to pass 434 and defeat 439. I can tell you that over \$7 million was spent by opponents in defeating 435. This defeat means LB1402 will not be in place in the future for Nebraska families. This of course is unfortunate as we had 96 kids and over \$231,700 in scholarship money awarded to Aquinas families this school year. This would have been the positive impact to our school as we continue to try to make tuition affordable for our families. I know many have spoken to Laura and Alina about how to use this money that is coming to our families. I would strongly encourage saving that scholarship money for the 25-26 school year as that scholarship will not be available to families next school year.
- Advent This weekend we begin the great season of Advent. A perfect time to renew and recommit
 ourselves to the Lord as we prepare for Christmas. As look at our Advent wreathe with its four candles,
 we can focus on those four themes: Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love. We can also focus our attention on
 being more alert and vigilant of God's presence in our lives. As always, a great way of preparation is
 the healing power of Confession. The Deanery wide day for confession is Sunday December 15th. All
 parishes will have times for confession that day as well as additional times before Christmas. Please go
 to confession as a family this Advent Season in preparation for Christmas.

Current news

- Semester finals- The schedule for semester finals is on the next page. Please be sure to encourage your student(s) to prepare well for finals as they account for 20% of the semester grade.
- MAP testing- MS/HS will begin MAP testing in early December. The elementary school has been using
 MAP testing for a few years now, and the entire diocese may be moving toward MAP testing as a
 replacement for the ITBS testing we have been doing after the current contract expires at the end of this
 year. MAP testing will be useful to us, especially in providing more frequent data to track progress and
 measure growth (3 times per year vs. once).
- School absences- While it is not ready yet, we are working with the Ed Tech office to set up the ability for
 parents to submit absences from school directly on the parents' PowerSchool account rather than having
 to call the office. I will send out more information when I have it.
- Credit loss due to absence (HS only)- This is a reminder that HS students who miss any individual class 10
 or more times in one semester are at risk of losing credit for that class. There is an appeal process if a
 student is <u>informed</u> they are losing credit. Please refer to the handbook to read more on this policy.
- Community service hours- Reminder that community service hours need to be submitted to your student's Society teacher within 30 days of any service hours being completed!

THE ASVAB - UPDATE

The junior class received their ASVAB results this past month. We spent a class period going over the results AND created accounts for the ASVAB college and career exploration program called OCCU-Find. The OCCU-Find combines each student's strengths (determined by the ASVAB assessment) and their unique interests to come up with a list of potential careers that would help them find satisfying occupations. The OCCU-Find also has an educational component that allows students to discover what is required for each occupation, and gives them a list of institutions that provide that education.

FAFSA - SENIOR PARENT MEETING

The school counselors from DCHS and AQHS are partnering to bring valuable information regarding the FAFSA - Federal Application for Student Aid, to all Senior parents in the David City Community.
